Steeped in history, this heritage home was built in 1915 by Malcolm F Uren, father of Malcolm J Uren, who would go on to become editor of the Western Mail.

Having been lovingly and meticulously restored, the home retains most of its original character features, with sweeping stone steps leading through serene gardens up to a wide verandah with timber decking, exposed beams and leadlight windows to the inside.

This is a fairy-tale home, with reclaimed jarrah timber flooring, high ceilings, stunning architraves and original fireplaces in most rooms.


